Welcome to Devizes Half Marathon

The charming historic market town of Devizes lies at the very heart of Wiltshire. Founded in Norman times at the boundaries (the Latin 'ad Divisas') of surrounding villages, the town grew up around the castle. The outline of the town walls shows in the 'D' shape of the centre which retains its mediaeval street plan. The town is compact and, being on the level, easy to walk round. Some buildings survive from the 16thC including the renowned hat shop in St John's Alley.

Devizes is lucky to have kept many small independent shops offering a wide range of goods not found elsewhere - with service to match. Weekly general and collectors' markets and regular farmers' and continental markets bring added colour.

The spectacular Caen Hill flight of 29 locks leading up to Devizes was a major engineering feat when built at the end of the 18thC. The tow path from the Wharf leads to the locks and provides excellent views of the countryside. Boat hire and trips on the canal are available in the summer.



Venue

The Green, Devizes, Wiltshire, SN10 3AA.

Will I receive a bib number in the post?

No, we will not be posting out bib numbers and timing chips, you must collect this at the venue prior to your race.



Want to collect your race number early?

You are able to collect your race number and timing chip on Saturday 21st March. You can also ask any questions and drive the route too. We will be signing the course from 11:00.

What to do when you arrive - Chip Collection from 08:00

On arrival, please check the information board for your race number, then queue accordingly, if you do not know your race number, you will be asked to find this. You will then be issued with an envelope with your race number on. Please check this is your number.

Race Number & Timing Chip, Half Marathon - 9:30, age 17+

You will be issued with a race number, which must be pinned to the front of your running top, a baggage tag, a timing chip and ankle strap, which must be attached to your left ankle. Please complete the medical information on the reverse of your bib prior to pinning it to your top.

No Chip = No Time, NO EXCEPTIONS.

There are no day entries for this event. Online entries will close prior to the event, we will post this deadline via the website closer to the event.

Toilets

There will be 6 portable toilets on The Green which can be used at any time before and after the event. Please do not use hedgerows and residents' gardens.

There is one toilet located at the 2nd water station, at 7 miles.

Baggage - sponsored by Grist Environmental

If you wish to leave car keys, please put these into your envelope and take to the baggage truck. Any bags can also be kept here, ensure you have a baggage tag attached with your race number.

No tag, no storage.

Personal MP3 Players & iPods

The use of any personal music device, headphones or other audio device are not permitted during this event and will result in disqualification if caught wearing them. There will be spotter marshals on the course looking for these. Bone conductor headphones **are not** permitted during our event.

Medical

There will be a hard standing first aid point at the start/finish area on The Green and there will be the ability to mobilise a first aider from the start/finish. There will be a first aid point at mile 2, 7 and 11. Should you or any other runner require first aid, alert the nearest marshal.

Massage

There is no confirmed massage at this event. If we can secure a late provider we will add this to the website.

Photography

Charles Whitton Photography will be taking photos during this event and they will be available to buy shortly after, the link will be available from our results page.

Pacing team

We have several pace runners for this event which will be targeting the finish time at a steady pace - see website for pace runner times.

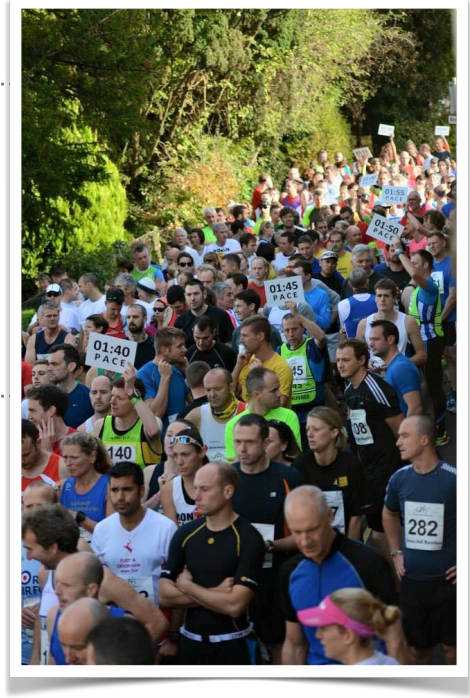
Water Stations

There will be a water station at approximately 4.3 miles, 7 miles, 9.5 miles and 11.3 miles. We will have 50ml paper cups available.

The water stations will be self serve in 2026 - so you need to slow down, collect your cup from the table and dispose of it, our teams will be filling cups but not handing them out, this is for a few reasons, to encourage you to carry what you need, to reduce litter on the course, to reduce missed cups by not grabbing one. Please do not swipe the whole table knocking several cups off as this is poor sportsmanship.

These paper cups are a recyclable alternative to plastic cups. If you require more than 50ml of water per station, please carry a bottle or use a running vest.

Disposal stations after each station are available, please only use these large waste bags for rubbish, do not drop gel wrappers, cups or bottles anywhere else on course. Help keep our countryside tidy.



Littering

We have a litter drop zone up to 50m after each drinks station. Littering is prohibited anywhere else on the course. Please keep hold of gel wrappers and litter until the finish line. Dropping litter outside of these zones is prohibited.
